What's the Warming Shelter?


Temperatures are projected to drop dramatically in the coming weeks and months. The San Leandro community must do all we can to avoid having someone die on the streets, as one Hayward man and several in the Bay Area did last winter.

This winter, April Showers/Interfaith Homeless Network and Building Futures

are launching a pilot project that will identify and reach out to homeless people living on the streets of San Leandro. Dinner, overnight shelter, and breakfast will be provided at a Warming Shelter during rainy or very cold weather. The shelter's location is being confirmed.

On nights when the weather is forecast to be 38 degrees or colder or rain is predicted, the Warming Shelter would be open. It is expected that the shelter will be open about 50 nights this winter.

The Shelter will be overseen by the project's outreach manager and two staff members. The
